Principled Innovation® Bot

Facilitation Guide

The Principled Innovation[®] Bot is designed to help individuals and teams explore innovative ideas through the lens of the PI framework. This is not like other bots, it will not directly answer your questions, but gives you a reflective response. It serves as a thought partner, offering structured guidance in decision-making, ethical reflection, and creative problem-solving. While the PI Bot can support your thinking, it is not intended to replace human judgment, instead, it is designed to complement diverse human perspectives and encourage collaborative exploration.

This bot is currently only available to ASU affiliated users on the CreateAl platform. **An ASURITE ID is required to login.**

Getting Started

To get started, simply type your thoughts, questions, or ideas into the message box—just like you would in a chat with a colleague. Once you're ready, press "Enter" or click the arrow on the right side to send your message and begin the conversation with the bot. There's no special format needed—just start typing!

After using the bot, you can start a new chat by clicking "+ New Chat" at the top left corner of the page.

Use Ideas

You can use the PI Bot in a variety of ways, depending on your goals and context. Below are some suggested prompts and use ideas. These are only examples of how you can use it, and you do not have to follow them exactly:

For ASU Students

- 1. **Personal Growth Reflection:** Ask the bot, "How can I apply empathy and humility in my group projects?" to explore character development in academic or co-curricular settings.
- 2. **Ethical Decision Practice:** Present a campus-related ethical dilemma (e.g., academic honesty, inclusion) and have the bot guide reflection using the Principled Innovation (PI) framework.

- 3. **Collaborative Learning:** Use the bot to structure team discussions, helping members consider multiple perspectives before making group decisions.
- 4. **Scenario Exploration:** Generate a random scenario and practice applying Pl's moral, civic, intellectual, and performance domains to navigate it.
- 5. **Career Preparation:** Ask, "How can I demonstrate Principled Innovation in job interviews or internships?" to connect PI concepts to professional readiness.

For ASU Staff

- 1. **Team Planning Partner:** Use the bot as a thought partner in planning meetings—e.g., "Help us integrate PI into our staff retreat agenda."
- 2. **Ethical Reflection Tool:** When facing operational or leadership challenges, prompt: "Guide me through the ethical implications of this workplace decision."
- 3. **Character-Based Leadership:** Explore how assets like courage or collaboration can strengthen leadership and workplace culture.
- 4. **PI Integration in Initiatives:** Ask, "How might we align our department goals with the PI framework?" to foster mission-driven work.
- 5. **Scenario Training:** Use the bot to create workplace scenarios that help staff practice reflection, empathy, and inclusive decision-making.

For ASU Faculty

- 1. **Curriculum Design:** Ask, "How can I embed the Civic domain of PI into my existing course activity?" to enrich learning outcomes.
- 2. **Reflective Teaching:** Use the bot to design a reflection exercise that encourages students to examine moral or intellectual character.
- 3. **Ethics in the Classroom:** Present a discipline-specific dilemma (e.g., Al use, research integrity) and let the bot model ethical inquiry through PI.
- 4. **Interdisciplinary Collaboration:** Co-create course modules or assignments that bridge PI with other frameworks (e.g., sustainability, leadership).
- 5. **Faculty Development:** Use the bot to plan or evaluate workshops for colleagues that explore how Principled Innovation informs pedagogy and academic culture.

Uploader Feature

The uploader feature allows you to submit your own lesson plans or documents for the bot to augment with Principled Innovation perspectives.

Ways to use the uploader feature:

- **Curriculum Design:** Upload curricula and ask the bot to suggest how to embed PI into activities or discussions.
- **Ethical Reflection:** Prompt the bot to evaluate the ethical implications of leadership or instructional decisions.
- Activity Development: Use the bot to brainstorm reflective exercises, dilemmas, or character-focused activities (such as a character walk) connected to PI domains.
